CITY OF MISSION VIEJO

The City of Mission Viejo is transitioning to district elections, and community input is needed. Currently, voters across the entire City elect all five City Council Members through an at-large elections system. A district-based election divides the City into separate districts, each with one City Council Member who resides in the district and is selected by the voters in that particular district.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED

The City will hold a series of public hearings and community workshops to receive public input on where district lines should be drawn. At these events, you can share feedback and suggestions for new district lines in the City of Mission Viejo.

Public input is also welcome on the website under *Submit Districting Comments*.
