A Proclamation of the City Council of the City of Mission Viejo
Proclaiming November 2016, to Be

American Diabetes Month

Whereas, in the United States, nearly 30 million people – including an estimated 250,000 in Orange County have diabetes, a serious disease with potentially life-threatening complications such as heart disease, stroke, blindness, kidney disease and amputation; and

Whereas, an additional 86 million people in the United States are at risk for developing type 2 diabetes; and

Whereas, recent estimates project that as many as one in three American adults will have diabetes in 2050 if current trends continue; and

Whereas, an increase in community awareness is necessary to put a stop to the diabetes epidemic.

Now, therefore, I, Frank Ury, by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Mission Viejo and on behalf of the City Council, do hereby proclaim November 2016, to be **American Diabetes Month** in Mission Viejo and do call upon all citizens to come together and fight diabetes by becoming more involved in changing the future of this deadly disease.
