The Burger Boss restaurant is expanding from the Inland Empire to open its first Orange County location in Mission Viejo's Portola Plaza at 27690 Santa Margarita Parkway. Tenant improvement plans have been submitted to the City of Mission Viejo and the restaurant is expected to open early summer between TJ Maxx and Tacos & Company.

Burger Boss is a family-owned and operated restaurant known for its made-to-order burgers, fries and shakes. The menu also includes chicken sandwiches, turkey and black-bean burgers, hot dogs, grilled-cheese sandwiches and sweet potato fries.
