

SCHOOL TRAFFIC SAFETY

If you drive your children to and from school,
it is very important that you follow
the traffic safety plan listed below:

- **Share rides** with other families to reduce the number of cars around each school.
- **Leave a few minutes early** and allow plenty of time before drop-off and pick-up times. Give your children their money, school papers, and hugs and kisses before they get to school.
- **Use the school's circulation plan** and designated drop-off and pick-up areas.
- **Do not park in red zones** or in front of residential driveways. Park legally, even if it's farther away from the school grounds.
- **Do not double park** (stopping in the traffic lane) to drop off or pick up your child.
- **Drop off/pick up your children at safe locations.** Do not pick a place where your children must cross through traffic. If they do need to cross a street, have your children use the intersections or crosswalks especially with crossing guards.
- **Do not make U-turns** near the school or turn around using a private driveway.
- **Obey the 25 mph speed limit** in residential/school areas, all traffic signs, and school crossing guards.



Be Courteous to the Neighbors



- Drive slowly (25 mph).
- Do not block or park in private driveways.
- Do not leave trash or move trash cans.
- Always be polite to other drivers and children.
- Teach your children to respect the neighborhood's private property.
