Election Summary - 1 - I-003

On October 23, 1989, the Mission Viejo City Council voted to consolidate its General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election to achieve increased voter turnout and cost savings. This changed the General Municipal Election date from April to November 6, 1990, and extended elected officeholders' terms.
