My ideas are as follows:

The Excel worksheets and the supplied maps were easy to work with. I was surprised by the 7% population spread in the proposed Plan A. Using the Census data and the contiguity requirement I was able to modify Map A to achieve a much lower spread. I'm assuming the large spread in the proposed Map A was due to the inclusion of other factors such as utility providers and school districts.

These other entities already have their own boards elected by citizens and/or subject the oversight of the elected county, state and federal government officials. I would prefer that Mission Viejo Council representation spread not be increased to overlay the boundaries of these other entities. In the rare case of a problem serious enough that Council input was required the involvement of two or more Council members would be more powerful.

I'm assuming the Council has, or will have, details of where factors other than population entered in the Center for Demographic Research's Map A recommendation. Is that the case? Some sort of narrative would be helpful in evaluating their recommendation.


Using the supplied Excel worksheets, I reduced the 7% population spread with a modified Map A to a little over 1%. This required moving only six blocks to different districts. Two key moves were extending District 1 south along the canyon and incorporating the Lake block into District 3.

These changes to only six blocks significantly reduce the population spread while maintaining most of original Map A at the expense of only slightly more complicated boundaries.
