We reviewed your request dated September 30, 1997, for a Letter of Map Amendment. All required information for this request was received on November 18, 1997. Using the information submitted and the effective National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) map, we determined portions of the property described below are in a Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA), the area that would be inundated by the flood having a 1-percent chance of being equaled or exceeded in any given year (base flood); however, the six structures on the property are not in the SFHA.

Property Description: Parcels 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, and 10, Highpark Office Park Complex, Parcel Map No. 89-132, as shown on the Plat recorded as Instrument No. 90-594518, in Book 258, Pages 23 and 24, in the Office of the Recorder, Orange County, California

Street Address: 26056, 26060, 26050, 26030, 26020, and 26034 Acero

Flooding Source: Aliso Creek

This letter amends the above-referenced NFIP map to remove the six structures from the SFHA. The structures are now in Zone X (unshaded), an area of minimal flooding outside the SFHA. Flood insurance coverage for the structures may be available under a low-cost policy (see enclosed document). Because portions of the property remain in the SFHA, any future construction or substantial improvement on the property remains subject to Federal, State, and local regulations for floodplain management.
