

## RESOLUTION 17-36

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MISSION VIEJO, CALIFORNIA TO SUPPORT THE TRANSPORTATION CORRIDOR AGENCIES IN SOLVING REGIONAL TRAFFIC RELIEF IN SOUTH ORANGE COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Transportation Corridor Agencies, in collaboration with the Orange County Transportation Authority, Caltrans and the County of Orange have embarked upon a comprehensive public process to relieve traffic congestion in South Orange County; and

WHEREAS, Mission Viejo, along with other cities, have participated in this endeavor as part of the South Orange County Mobility Working Group studying many variables impacting the region including demographic changes, projected traffic growth and environmental considerations to name a few; and

WHEREAS, the City of Mission Viejo supports the Transportation Corridor Agencies' efforts to identify a balanced solution to relieving regional, and particularly north-south traffic congestion, which could include a State Route 241 to Interstate 5 connection; and


WHEREAS, the City of Mission Viejo encourages their fellow South Orange County cities to embrace the public process to be carried forward to completion; and

WHEREAS, most South Orange County cities, including Mission Viejo, are participants in these traffic relief efforts as either State Route 241 or State Route 73 are within their city boundaries, providing access and choice to residents and businesses; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon all South Orange County cities to embrace a public process to identify solutions that alleviate traffic gridlock on Interstate 5 and improve the quality of life for its residents and the commuting public while supporting the protection of Trestles, the California State Park and the San Mateo Watershed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Mission Viejo supports the Transportation Corridor Agencies and their partners as they pursue regional mobility solutions that will relieve traffic flow for the residents of Mission Viejo and South Orange County.
