## **RECEIVE ALERTS**

**FROM THE CITY OF MISSION VIEJO IN AN EMERGENCY**

*This targeted notification system will alert you when there is an imminent threat to life safety with required actions including evacuation orders.*

All landline phone numbers are preregistered in the system. You need to register your address, cell phone for calls and text messages, email address, and TDD/TYY devices. You can register multiple addresses, phone numbers, and emails including your home, work, etc.

# Emergency Kit Checklist

**Make a Kit, Get a Plan, Be Informed!**

## Create an emergency kit for your home, office, school or vehicle:

- Water**—one gallon per person, per day (3-day supply for evacuation, 2-week supply for home)
- Food**—non-perishable, easy-to-prepare items (3-day supply for evacuation, 2-week supply for home)
- Flashlight**
- Radio** battery-powered or hand-crank (NOAA Weather Radio, if possible)
- Extra batteries**
- First-aid kit** (whistle, antibiotic ointment, bandages, face masks, gloves and reference book)
- Medications** (7-day supply) and medical items, hearing aids with extra batteries, glasses, contact lenses, syringes, etc.
- Multi-purpose tool**
- Sanitation and personal hygiene items**, including bleach
- Copies of personal documents** (medication list and pertinent medical information, proof of address, deed/lease to home, passports, birth certificates, insurance policies)
- Cell phone** with chargers
- Family and emergency contact information**
- Extra cash**
- Emergency blanket**, extra clothes, sleeping bags
- Map(s)** of the area
- Baby supplies** (bottles, formula, baby food, diapers)
- Games** and activities for children

Also, extra keys, can opener and don't forget supplies for your animals.
