

Volleyball Courts

Volleyball Courts will be reserved for 80 minutes at a time. We will only permit up to 4 people per reservation for 2-on-2 matches. The schedule is listed below:

Tues/Thurs 3 pm / 4:30 pm / 6 pm

Volleyball is free for members and \$3 per person for non-members. Non-members and members with frozen accounts must submit their reservation requests via email at fitness@cityofmissionviejo.org.

UPON ARRIVAL

- Check in with staff at the community room behind the black gate (follow the arrows to the open door).
- Each family member should wear a mask when entering, exiting, and moving through the center. Masks can be removed while you are on your court playing. Families will be asked to complete a waiver for each member if one is not already on file.
- Restrooms are located near the grass area by the volleyball courts, and hand sanitizer is available at check-in outside the community room. Please remember to wear your mask at all times when you are not on the court.
- Families are to remain on their volleyball court and should not linger on the patio, which is closed. If your ball goes out of bounds, please check walk ways before retrieving it to promote social distancing guidelines.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for everyone in their party.

LEAVING

- As you exit the volleyball court, all players should put on their face mask and follow the one-way directional arrows toward the tennis courts and around the far side of the patio by the pickleball courts to ultimately exit through the main gate. This is to maintain appropriate social distancing from groups that are arriving for reservation play and coincides with the one-way walkways.

CLEANING

- Equipment will not be provided. Families must bring their own volleyball for reservation play. The facility restrooms and high-touch point areas are regularly disinfected to promote a safer space for recreation play. Players are encouraged to wash their hands or use hand sanitizer before and after play.

CODE OF CONDUCT

All participants are expected to follow all COVID-19 facility safety guidelines. People who do not comply or whose conduct is disruptive may be asked to leave. Any violation that continues after notice from staff may result in denial of future facility usage.
