

# EMERGENCY RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

for Orange County Renters



The **County of Orange** will offer rental households, up to **\$10,000 in financial assistance** for unpaid rent or utility bills due to the impact of **COVID-19**.

**Accepting applications starting April 1.**

Will only be accepted until April 30, 2021.

## Eligibility requirements include:



Eligible expenses are **UNPAID rent or utility bills** due to COVID-19 impact only, not future rent or utility costs. You must also meet income requirement as stated below.

Households with one or more members currently experiencing unemployment for 90 days or more at the time of application and have an annual income at or below **80% Area Median Income (AMI)**

**OR** household with an annual income at or below **50% AMI**, regardless of employment status.
